

**CO-PAYMENT DISPARITIES BY COUNTY FOR A FAMILY OF THREE WITH AN INCOME OF \$32,200/year**

<b>COUNTY</b>	<b>COUNTY MULTIPLIERS</b>	<b>ANNUAL/WEEKLY FEE</b>
<i>In Cattaragus, Livingston, Otsego and Schoharie counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>10%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$1660 per year, or \$32 per week</b></i>
<i>In Delaware and Nassau counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>17.5%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$2905 per year, or \$56 per week</b></i>
<i>In Allegany, Clinton, Columbia, Essex, Fulton, Ontario, Putnam, Saratoga, Schenectady, Tompkins, Washington and Westchester counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>20%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$3320 per year, or \$64 per week</b></i>
<i>In Albany, Chautauqua, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Madison, Monroe, Rensselaer, Schuyler, St. Lawrence, Suffolk, Tioga, Ulster, Warren and Wayne counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>25%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$4150 per year, or \$80 per week</b></i>
<i>In Dutchess, Franklin, Steuben and Wyoming counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>30%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$4980 per year, or \$96 per week</b></i>
<i>In Broome, Cayuga, Chemung, Chenango, Cortland, Erie, Genesee, Greene, Montgomery, Niagara, Onondaga, Oneida, Orange, Orleans, Oswego, Rockland, Seneca, Sullivan, and Yates counties</i>	<i>parents pay <b>35%</b> of their income over the poverty level for a child care subsidy</i>	<i>this means they pay <b>\$5810 per year, or \$112 per week</b></i>
